With explanation of Rashi, Tosafos, and Tosafos Yeshanim, and laws of Tosafos, Rabbienu Asher, digest of the laws of the Rosh by his son Rabbienu Yaakov Baal HaTurim ז"ל, and notes of Ashri from מה"מ Yisroel of Kremtz ז"ל, and the explanation of Mishnayos by the Rambam ז"ל, explanation Rabbienu Shimshon of Shantz ז"ל, explanation Rabbienu Asher ז"ל on the Mishnayos seder Zeraim and Teharos.
